

MINUTES OF LLANYNYS COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON

1. WELCOME BY THE CHAIR

The chair welcomed everyone to the meeting and then introduced Councillor Maggie Smith who provided the Council with a summary of her role, as an observer, and confirmed her report would go to the next Denbighshire Standards Committee in June.

2. APOLOGIES

Received from Councillors Iona Jones and Dewi Roberts, and County Councillor Merfyn Parry

3. DECLARATION OF INTEREST

The Clerk stated that he was aware that there was a possible Declaration of Interest required regarding Agenda Item 10 (c) Obstruction of Gate at Rhewl Pavilion. He detailed the three possibilities for a "Declaration" – those of personal, prejudicial or a disclosable pecuniary interest (DPI) for the Councillors to consider, before the meeting reached this item. At this point Councillor Gwyn Howatson chose to leave the meeting.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF MEETING – 13 January 2026

The minutes were confirmed as correct and signed by the Chair.

5. MATTERS ARISING

**Meeting date 15/07/25**

Point 11 (f) - Speed Sign – The Clerk confirmed he had now received a reply to his e-mails, from Rebecca Musgrave, confirming that the survey required would have to be repeated and she would then inform us of the outcome. **The Clerk to then circulate the Council to confirm any further action necessary.**

Point 11 (d) Section 6 Action Plan – The Clerk confirmed that this needed to be completed and **he would contact One Voice Wales for guidance on this.**

**Meeting date 13/01/26**

Point 7 Land adjoining Awatea, Rhewl – The Clerk stated that there had been no further correspondence and Councillor Merfyn Parry would be following this up with Denbighshire County Council at their next Planning meeting.

Point 10 (b) Code of Conduct – The Clerk confirmed that the guidance had been circulated and requested the Councillors to sign the form as confirmation of their agreement to adopt this formally.

Point 10 (c) Standing Orders / Financial Regulations – The Clerk confirmed that he was in the process of reviewing and revising the One Voice Wales Draft Standing Orders and Financial Regulations and would, hopefully, have the final version available for approval at the Annual General Meeting.

6. FINANCIAL REPORT

7. PLANNING APPLICATIONS

The Clerk reported that there had been no new applications, but he had received notification of a proposed upgrade to a base station at Golf Links Farm, Rhewl, LL15 2UE and there was 14 days to provide any comments. Council agreed that there was no need for any comment as the impact appeared to be minimal.

8. UPDATES FROM THE COUNTY

The Clerk provided a summary, and gave examples, on the current tests of the Lorawan system being undertaken by Denbighshire County Council.

9. COMPLAINTS

10. ANY OTHER BUSINESS

- a) **Flooded Roads between Bodynys, Rhewl and Llanynys** – Councillor Merfyn Parry had asked Denbighshire County Council to review this matter. Investigations had taken place and a further investigation was due which would then be reported back when completed.
- b) **Highways Issues -**  
Councillor Sian Davies had raised issues over Highways matters near to her property. **The Clerk asked for a location map to be provided of the defects, and he would then submit all information to DCC.**
- c) **Obstruction of Entrance to Rhewl Pavilion**  
The Clerk informed the meeting that he had been contacted by the Rhewl Playing Fields Association with a request to support possible further action against a resident who was frequently parking over the entrance to the pavilion. Following a lengthy discussion, it was agreed that **the Clerk would send a letter to the resident with a request that they would refrain from parking at this location** and that the Council would support any action that the Playing Fields would take, if the matter persisted.
